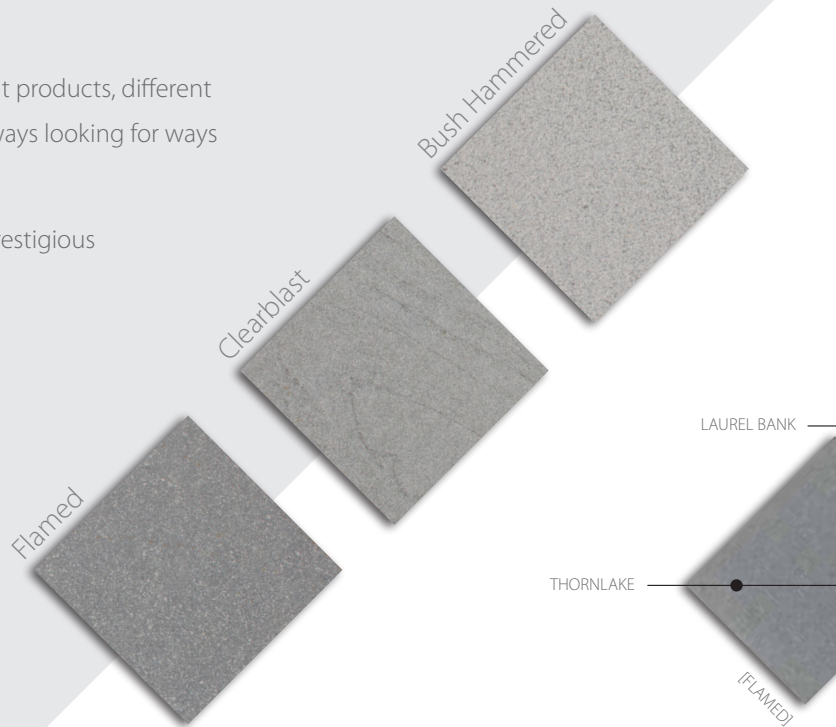

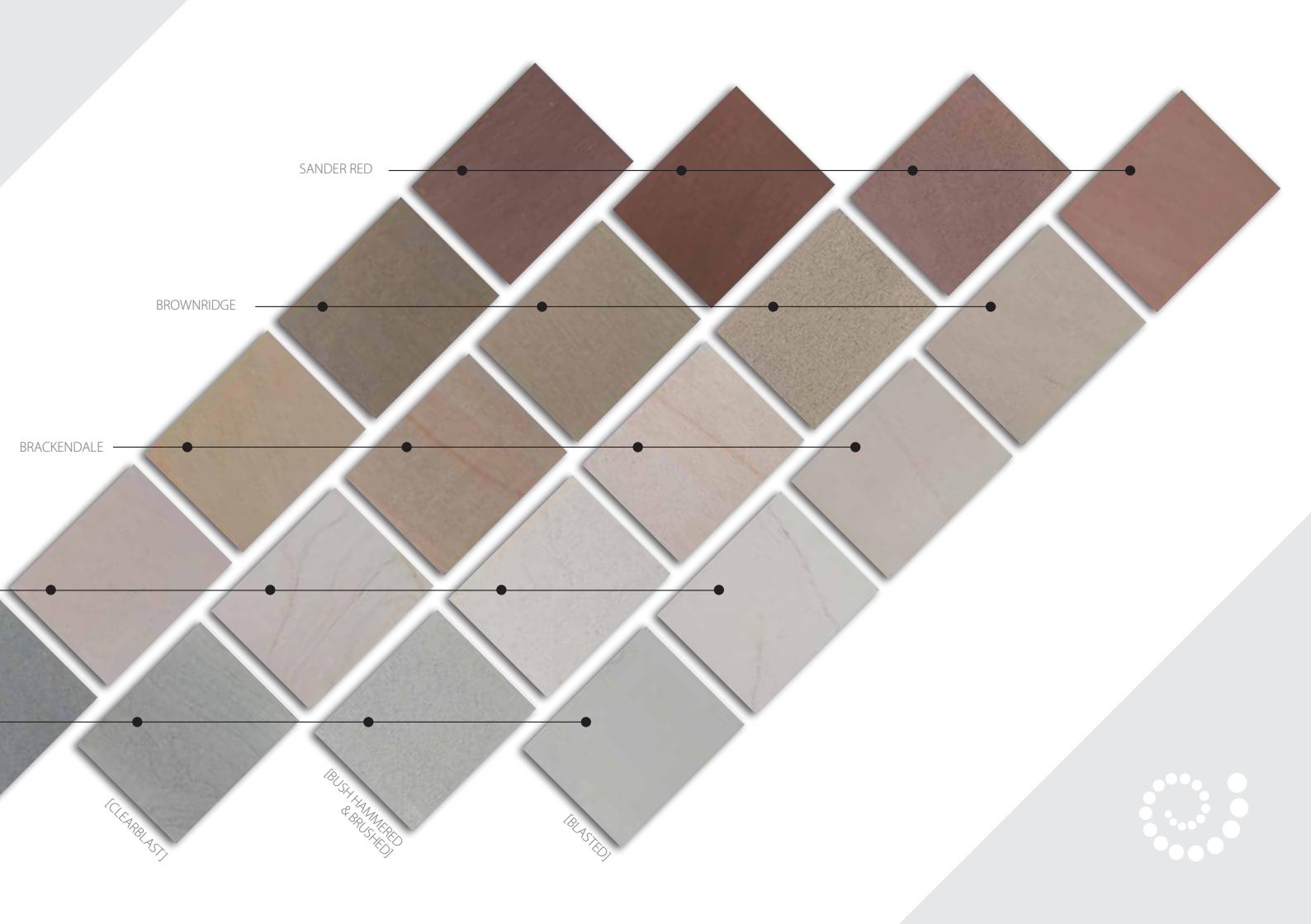

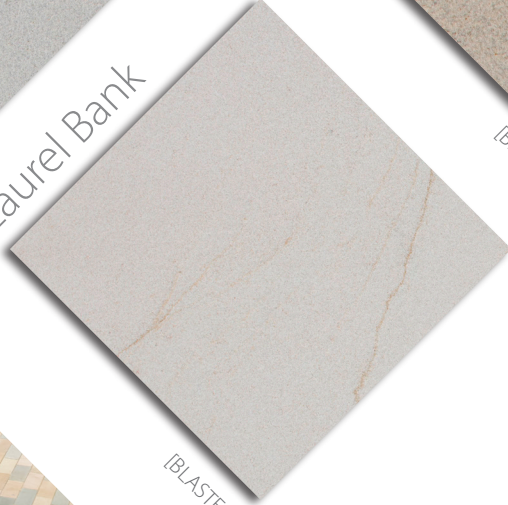

The architects, Gustafson Porter & Bowman's, landscape design has created intrigue through the use of angular zones comprising of precision cut bespoke rhombus shaped sandstone.

Alternating sections of cream Laurel Bank sandstone and buff / brown Brownridge sandstone are intersected by bands of grey Thornlake sandstone, black granite and Stainless Steel strips.

The remarkable diamond shaped sandstone had to be meticulously cut to maintain the crisp linear flow of the space.

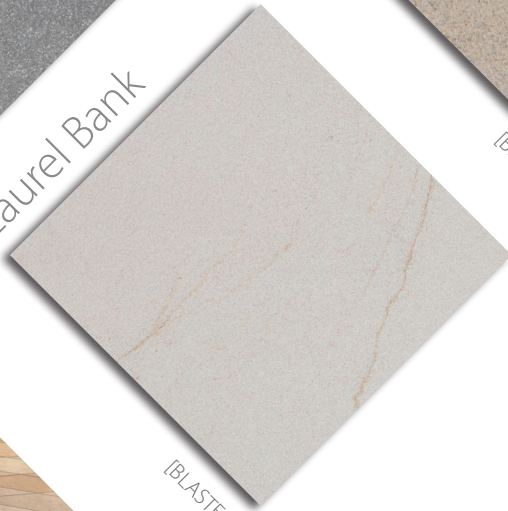
